SPARKLING - ITALY

1. Adria Vini Dolci Terre Prosecco Spumante (11.0% ABV) **£39.50**
A vibrant and refreshing Prosecco with lively bubbles. Bright notes of green apple, pear, and white peach lead to a crisp, clean finish. Perfect as an aperitif or for any celebration.

2. Adria Vini Dolci Terre Prosecco Spumante Rosé (11.0% ABV) **£42.50**
A delightful rosé Prosecco with a pale pink colour and fine, persistent perlage. Fresh aromas of wild strawberries, raspberries, and citrus blossoms precede a delicately fruity and well-balanced palate.

CHAMPAGNE- FRANCE

3. Ruinart Blanc de Blancs NV (12.5% ABV) 37.5cl **£80.00**
This Champagne is made exclusively from Chardonnay. Ruinart's expression is the epitome of elegance and finesse, offering delicate notes of citrus, green apple, white flowers, and subtle brioche complexity from gentle ageing. **£135.00**

4. Laurent-Perrier Rosé NV (12.5% ABV) **£125.00**
A benchmark for rosé Champagne, Laurent-Perrier Rosé is renowned for its vibrant and precise style. Made using the saignée method to achieve its beautiful salmon-pink hue, it delivers intense, fresh red berry flavour - strawberry, raspberry, and redcurrant - with a refined, elegant finish.

5. Dom Pérignon Vintage 2015 (12.5% ABV) **£350.00**
An icon of the Champagne world, always released as a vintage cuvée and only in the finest years. The 2015 vintage is a wine of immense complexity and depth, harmonizing power and elegance. It reveals layers of white stone fruit, citrus zest, toasted almond, and a distinctive flinty minerality, with vibrant acidity and a remarkably long finish.

6. Krug, Grande Cuvée, 173ème Édition, Brut (12.5% ABV) **£375.00**
The ultimate expression of the Champagne maker's art. Each Édition is a multi-vintage blend of over 120 wines from more than 10 different years, crafted to achieve unparalleled fullness of flavours and generosity. The 173ème Édition offers an extraordinarily complex bouquet of ripe, dried, and citrus fruits, almond, marzipan, honey, and spices, with a sumptuous, full-bodied texture that lingers on the palate.

This revolutionary technology allows us to pour wines by the glass without removing the cork, preserving each bottle's quality and allowing you to enjoy rare vintages that would typically only be available by the bottle.

How Coravin Works: A fine, hollow needle pierces the foil and cork while argon gas (an inert, odourless preservative) gently pressurises the bottle. This allows wine to flow out while preventing oxidation. When the needle is removed, the cork naturally reseals itself, maintaining the remaining wine's freshness for weeks, months, or even years - just as if it were never opened.

For Full-Bodied Reds: Our Coravin Aerator instantly opens these wines, delivering the equivalent of 60-90 minutes of decanting in seconds. The result? Perfectly aerated, complex flavours in every glass.

WHITE

Jean Collet & Fils Chablis Vallions 2022 - Burgundy, France ABV 13%

Pure Chalk. Chablis is Chardonnay in its most mineral, saline form. From a top 1er Cru site, this wine is all about precision, razor-sharp acidity frames flavours of green apple, lemon zest and a profound wet stone minerality. It is lean, intense and incredibly long.

Domaine Christian Bellang Meursault 2022 - Burgundy, France ABV 13.5%

Textural Opulence. The antithesis of Chablis, Meursault from the Cote de Beaune is rich, round and textural. This wine is generously perfumed with white flowers, ripe peach and toasted hazelnuts. The palate is creamy and broad yet is perfectly balanced by a fresh mineral spine that keeps it vibrant.

Vieux Telegraphe Chateauneuf-du-Pape Rouge 2023 - Rhone Valley, France ABV 14.5%

The Power of the South. This legendary blend from the stony 'La Crau' plateau is the benchmark for Chateauneuf-du-Pape. It offers a compelling contrast of concentrated dark fruit, wild garrigue herbs and spicy complexity, all held together by robust structure.

Chateau Lagrange, Saint-Julien 2019 - Bordeaux, France ABV 13.5%

Classical Elegance. A textbook example of a left-bank Bordeaux from an outstanding vintage. It speaks of cassis, cedar cigar-box and pencil lead framed by polished, fine-grained tannins. This is a wine of harmony, restraint and formidable aging potential.

Domaine Felettig, Vosne-Romanee 2022 - Burgundy, France ABV 13%

Sordo Barolo 2019 - Piedmont, Italy ABV 14%

Tokaji Classic 5 Puttonyos 2016 - Tokaji, Hungary ABV 11%

Liquid Gold. From the world's oldest classified region, this wine is made from grapes affected by 'noble rot' which concentrates sugars and flavours. The result is an intensely luxurious yet balanced wine, with layers of apricot jam, honey, orange marmalade and spice, all lifted by a vibrant acidity that cleanses the palate.

BURGUNDY - FRANCE

Burgundy is the spiritual home of both Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, producing the world's most sought-after and age-worthy wines. The region's complex patchwork of vineyards, each with unique soil and aspect, gives every wine a distinct personality. The finest white wines come from the Côte de Beaune, home to the legendary villages of Puligny-Montrachet, Chassagne-Montrachet, and Meursault. Further north, Chablis produces a distinctly different, steely expression of Chardonnay from Kimmeridgian limestone soils. For reds, the Côte de Nuits is the realm of Grand Cru Pinot Noir, with villages like Vosne-Romanée producing wines of profound complexity and power.

WHITE

7. **Domaine Billard Pere Et Fils Hautes Cotes de Beaune Blanc La Justice 2024 (13.0% ABV)** £55.00

From the lesser-known hillsides above the Côte de Beaune, this offers brilliant value and a fresh, approachable style of Burgundy. It's a pure, mineral-driven Chardonnay with bright notes of crisp apple, lemon zest, and a touch of white flowers, supported by a vibrant, stony backbone.

8. **Michel Niellon Chassagne-Montrachet Clos de la Truffiere 1er Cru 'Chaumees' 2023 (13.0% ABV)** £220.00

From a top-tier producer, this premier cru is a stunning example of Chassagne-Montrachet's power and finesse. Sourced from a walled vineyard, it offers incredible depth and complexity: layers of ripe pear, white peach, toasted hazelnut, and a distinctive flinty minerality, all wrapped in a rich, textured palate with vibrant acidity.

9. **Domaine Christian Bellang Meursault 2022 (13.0% ABV)** £120.00

Meursault is renowned for its rich, buttery style of Chardonnay, and this village wine is a perfect introduction. Aged in oak barrels, it develops classic notes of toasted hazelnut, vanilla, and brioche, complementing ripe apple and citrus fruit. The palate is generous and round, with a long, creamy finish.

10. **Jean Collet et Fils Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons 2023 (12.5% ABV)** £95.00

One of the most highly regarded premier cru sites in Chablis, Montée de Tonnerre produces wines of great purity and power. This example is zesty and flinty, with classic green apple and citrus flavours underscored by a powerful saline minerality and a long, chalky finish. It is a textbook expression of fine Chablis.

11. **Gaelle et Jerome Meunier Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru 2023 (13.0% ABV)** £145.00

Puligny-Montrachet is the epitome of elegance and refinement in white Burgundy. This premier cru is beautifully balanced, combining the richness of the vintage with the tension of the appellation. Aromas of white peach, citrus blossom, and toasted almond lead to a precise, mineral-driven palate with a silky texture and impressive length.

12. **Eric Forest Pouilly-Fuissé 'L'Am' 2023 (13.5% ABV)** £85.00

From the heart of the Mâconnais, this Pouilly-Fuissé is a rich and expressive alternative to the more expensive Côte de Beaune wines. It offers generous notes of ripe pear, white flowers, and a hint of hazelnut, balanced by a vibrant, stony minerality and a full, satisfying finish.

RED

13. **Chateau de la Tour Clos-Vougeot, Grand Cru, Vieilles Vignes 2013 (13.5% ABV)** £550.00

Grand Cru from a walled vineyard, made from old vines. The "Vieilles Vignes" here average over 50 years, yielding concentrated, dark-fruited Pinot with notes of forest floor, truffle, and violets. The 2013 vintage is elegant rather than opulent built for the long haul.

14. **Michel Gros Echezeaux Loachaussees 2022 (13.5% ABV)** £650.00

Grand Cru, from a legendary producer. Rare and exquisite, displaying the ultimate expression of Pinot Noir. Michel Gros is a 6th-generation Vosne-Romanée master. The 2022 is a ripe, powerful vintage but retains soaring perfume - raspberry liqueur, peony, and spice with only a few barrels made.

15. **Henri et Gilles Remoriquet Nuits-St-Georges 1er Cru Les Bousselets 2021 (13.0% ABV)** £110.00

A premier cru from a top grower, structured and age-worthy with earthy, red-fruited notes of cherry and spice. Remoriquet is a cult-favourite, old-school Domaine. Les Bousselets sits just north of the town, producing firmer, more tannic Nuits than its neighbours. The cool 2021 vintage gives bright acidity and nervosity - think sour cherry, iron, and dried herbs.

16. **Sylvain Dussort Chorey-Les-Beaune 'Les Beaumonts' 2022 (13.0% ABV)** £82.00

A charming, approachable Burgundy from a village known for value. Chorey-lès-Beaune is often overshadowed by its grander neighbours, but top producers like Dussort reveal its quality. No new oak - just pure, juicy Pinot: raspberry, wild strawberry, and a whisper of rose petal.

LOIRE VALLEY

WHITE

The Loire Valley is a diverse and beautiful wine region, often called the "Garden of France." It produces a wide array of styles, but is particularly celebrated for its vibrant, terroir-driven white wines. In the east, Sancerre and Pouilly-Fumé are the world benchmarks for Sauvignon Blanc. Further west, Anjou-Saumur and Touraine are home to Chenin Blanc and more approachable Sauvignon blends.

17. **Sauvignon Blanc Haut-Poitou 2024 (12.5% ABV)** £42.50

From a region just south of the Loire Valley, this wine offers fantastic typicity and value. It's a crisp, herbaceous, and intensely aromatic Sauvignon Blanc, with classic notes of gooseberry, nettle, citrus zest, and a touch of boxwood, finishing clean and refreshing.

18. **Domaine de la Chezatte Sancerre 2024 (13.0% ABV)** £60.00

A classic Sancerre from a family-run Domaine. This wine perfectly captures the essence of the appellation, with a precise and elegant expression of Sauvignon Blanc. It offers vibrant grapefruit and lime notes, layered with fresh herbs, flinty minerality, and a long, zesty finish.

ALSACE WHITE

19. Domaine Bott-Geyl Riesling Les Éléments 2022 (12.5% ABV) £59.50

From a biodynamic pioneer in Alsace, this Riesling is a pure expression of fruit and terroir. It's a dry, racy wine with beautiful floral aromatics, vibrant citrus and green apple flavours, and a signature streak of stony minerality.

BORDEAUX

The two sides of the Gironde estuary produce wines with different characters. Left Bank wines are typically Cabernet Sauvignon-dominant, grown on gravelly soils that provide excellent drainage and retain heat. This results in wines with more structure, firm tannins, and notes of cassis, cedar, and tobacco, built for long ageing. In contrast, Right Bank wines are Merlot-dominant, thriving in the cooler, clay and limestone soils. These wines are known for being plush, rounder, and more approachable in their youth, often featuring ripe plum, chocolate, and violet notes.

RED

Left Bank (Cabernet Sauvignon Dominant)

20. Château Lynch-Bages 'Echo' 2015 (Pauillac) (13.0% ABV) £120.00

A classic, structured Bordeaux from a legendary vintage, with cassis, cedar, and firm structure. A more approachable "second wine" from the famous Château Lynch-Bages.

21. Château Lagrange Saint-Julien 2019 (13.5% ABV) £110.00

A beautifully balanced Cru Classé from a great vintage, offering a classic Saint-Julien profile of plum, blackcurrant, tobacco, and refined structure.

22. Château Kirwan 2019 (Margaux, 3ème Grand Cru Classé) 2019 (13.5% ABV) £125.00

A superb expression of Margaux from this historic Third Growth estate. The 2019 vintage is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Petit Verdot. It offers an elegant and complex nose of blackcurrant, violet, cedar, and subtle tobacco leaf.

Right Bank (Merlot Dominant)

23. Château Penin 'La Fleur' St Emilion Grand Cru 2023 (14.5% ABV) £68.00

A modern, elegant St-Emilion with generous dark fruit flavours and silky, well-integrated tannins. It's a vibrant and approachable Grand Cru.

24. Vieux Château Gachet Lalande de Pomerol 2019 (14.0% ABV) £72.00

Plush, velvety Merlot with blackberry and spice. Lalande-de-Pomerol offers a great value alternative to its famous neighbour, Pomerol, sharing similar rich and opulent characteristics.

BEAUJOLAIS RED

25. Fleurie Millésime Cave de Fleurie 2022 (13.0% ABV) £47.50

Juicy, floral Gamay with raspberry and violet. Fleurie is one of the most elegant and floral of the ten Beaujolais Crus, making this a wonderfully perfumed and approachable red.

RHÔNE VALLEY RED

26. Domaine Chante Cigale Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2022 (14.5% ABV) £75.00

A benchmark for the appellation, this full-bodied Grenache-dominant blend is rich with dark fruit, garrigue herbs, and a signature velvety texture.

ITALY, VENETO WHITE

27. Fattori Gregoris Soave 2023 – £38.00 (12.5% ABV) £38.00

Light, floral, with pear and almond notes.

28. Villa Angarano Chardonnay (12.5% ABV) £42.00

A fresh and vibrant Chardonnay from the Veneto, offering crisp green apple and citrus notes with a hint of white flowers.

RED

29. Recchia Valpolicella Classico 2023 (13.0% ABV) £42.00

A classic, everyday Valpolicella. It's light, cherry-driven, and easy-drinking with a touch of spice, perfect for chilling slightly.

30. Villa Belvedere Amarone della Valpolicella 2019 (15.5% ABV) £72.50

Rich, powerful, and raisiny. This iconic wine is made from partially dried grapes, a process that concentrates the sugars and flavours, resulting in intense dark fruit, high alcohol, and a velvety, warm finish.

PIEMONTE WHITE

31. Castillo Di Tassarolo Gavi Spinola 2024 (12.5% ABV) £46.00

Crisp, mineral Cortese grape with citrus and white peach.

RED

32. Sordo Barolo 2021 (14.5% ABV) £85.00

A classic expression from a great vintage. This Nebbiolo offers the iconic notes of rose, tar, and firm, structured tannins. Known as the "King of Wines," Barolo is powerful, tannic, and incredibly complex.

33. Sordo Barolo 2019 (Magnum, 150cl) (14.5% ABV) £170.00
Aged Nebbiolo with rose, tar, and firm tannins. Known as the "King of Wines," this large format is perfect for sharing and will age gracefully.

34. Sordo Gabutti Riserva 2021 (Jeroboam, 300cl) (14.5% ABV) £350.00
A Riserva Barolo from the esteemed Gabutti vineyard, meaning it has been aged longer to achieve even greater depth and complexity. The large-format Jeroboam is perfect for momentous celebrations and will age for decades.

TUSCANY RED

35. Tenuta Buono Tempo Brunello di Montalcino 2018 (14.5% ABV) £95.00
A superb example of this prestigious wine. Aged Sangiovese Grosso (the local clone) with leather, cherry, and spice. Brunello is one of Italy's most prestigious wines, requiring five years of aging before release.

36. Felsina Berardenga Chianti Classico Riserva 2020 (14.0% ABV) £58.00
A benchmark Chianti Classico Riserva, offering classic notes of violet, cherry, and earthy Sangiovese with well-structured tannins and a long, savoury finish.

NZ, MARLBOROUGH WHITE

37. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2024 (13.0% ABV) £72.00
Iconic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with passionfruit and lime intensity.

38. Hunter Riesling 2022 (12.0% ABV) £50.00
Off-dry Riesling with apple and floral notes.

39. Kumeu River Estate Chardonnay 2021 (13.5% ABV) £80.00
Burgundian-style Chardonnay with stone fruit and balanced oak; often compared to top white Burgundies at a fraction of the price.

RED

40. Soul Growers Equilibrium GSM 2023 (14.5% ABV) £60.00
A classic Barossa Valley blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre. It's jammy, spicy, and full of personality, with layers of red and dark fruit.

41. Shiraz, Organic Field Blend De Bortoli 2020 (14.0% ABV) £45.00
A bold, expressive Shiraz made from organically grown grapes. It's full of peppery, dark fruit flavours with a smooth, generous finish.

VICTORIA WHITE

42. Moorooduc Chardonnay 2024 (13.5% ABV) £65.00
A cool-climate Chardonnay from the Mornington Peninsula, offering elegance and focus with citrus and nectarine notes, underpinned by subtle, high-quality oak.

RED

43. Soumah, Yarra Valley 2022 (13.5% ABV) £48.00
From a renowned producer in the cool-climate Yarra Valley, this Pinot Noir exemplifies the region's elegant, food-friendly style. It offers vibrant red berry fruits, subtle spice, fine-grained tannins, and a long, balanced finish, showing the finesse of premium Victorian winemaking.

USA, CALIFORNIA WHITE

44. Tensley Fundamental Chardonnay 2022 (13.5% ABV) £65.00
Creamy, balanced Chardonnay with tropical fruit.

45. Rochioli Sauvignon Blanc 2024 (14.0% ABV) £95.00
From a renowned Russian River Valley producer, this is a rich, textural Sauvignon Blanc with notes of melon, grapefruit, and a distinct flinty minerality.

RED

46. Heitz Cellar Cabernet Sauvignon 2018 (Napa) (14.0% ABV) £180.00
An iconic, historic Napa Cab from a pioneer of the valley. It's a classic, age-worthy wine known for its pure blackcurrant fruit, minty freshness, and elegant structure.

47. Hitching Post Highliner Pinot Noir 2020 (California) (14.0% ABV) £78.00
Made famous by the film Sideways, this winery is a benchmark for approachable, flavourful California Pinot. It's medium-bodied and silky with vibrant red cherry and spice.

48. Clos Du Val Cabernet Sauvignon 2022 (California) (14.5% ABV) £110.00
A classic, structured Napa Cabernet that helped put the region on the map. It's known for its balance and finesse, offering cassis, vanilla, and refined tannins.

49. Rochioli Pinot Noir Estate 2023 (14.0% ABV) £110.00
From a legendary, family-owned producer in the Russian River Valley, this single-vineyard Pinot Noir is highly sought-after. It's celebrated for its pure, concentrated fruit expression, silky texture, and elegant structure.

SOUTH AFRICA, STELLENBOSCH

WHITE

50. Waterkloof Circle of Life White 2024 (13.0% ABV) £48.00

A biodynamic blend of Chenin Blanc and Sauvignon Blanc, this wine is fresh and vibrant with notes of green apple, pear, and a hint of herbal complexity.

51. Lismore Chardonnay 2022 (13.0% ABV) £45.00

From a high-altitude vineyard in the Cape South Coast, this is a rich, layered Chardonnay with citrus and spice, showing great purity and finesse.

RED

52. Springfield Estate 'The Work of Time' 2023 (14.5% ABV) £62.00

A sophisticated Bordeaux-style blend, showcasing the incredible potential of South African Cabernet Sauvignon. It's a wine of great depth with dark fruit, firm structure, and a long, savoury finish.

53. Syrah 'The Pack' Painted Wolf 2022 (13.5% ABV) £64.00

A medium-bodied, spicy Syrah from the Swartland region, known for its old vines and Rhône-style blends. It's expressive with black pepper, smoked meat, and dark berries.

SPAIN, RÍAS BAIXAS

54. Domingo Martín Albariño 2024 (12.5% ABV) £44.00

Zesty, saline Albariño with peach and citrus.

RIOJA

RED

55. Bodegas Ontañón Rioja Gran Reserva 2011 (14.0% ABV) £65.00

A superb example of traditional Rioja. Gran Reserva signifies extended oak aging (at least 2 years in oak and 3 in bottle), creating a smooth, complex, and savoury wine with notes of vanilla, tobacco, leather, and dried cherry.

RIBERA DEL DUERO

RED

56. Damián 5 Tinto Ribera del Duero 2022 (14.5% ABV) £42.50

A powerful and concentrated Tempranillo (known locally as Tinto Fino) that showcases the region's intensity. It's packed with ripe blackberry, oak spice, and firm, age-worthy tannins.

AUSTRIA, NIEDERÖSTERREICH

WHITE

57. Grüner Veltliner (12.0% ABV) £42.50

Peppery, crisp white with green apple and white pepper.

JAPAN

58. Akashi-Tai Brewery Junmai Tokubetsu Sake NV (30cl) (15.0% ABV) £35.00

A smooth, well-balanced sake with a mellow aroma of rice and fruit, offering flavours of steamed rice, melon, and a clean, crisp finish.

ARGENTINA, UCO VALLEY

RED

59. Sottana Malbec 2024 (13.5% ABV) £42.00

A vibrant and juicy Malbec from the high-altitude Uco Valley. It's plum-driven with soft, approachable tannins and a fresh finish.

60. Malbec Opalo, Maurice Lorca 2022 (14.0% ABV) £60.00

A more elegant and floral expression of Malbec, showcasing the finesse possible in the Uco Valley. It offers delicate violet notes, dark fruit, and a silky texture.
