

Gin List 2023

SCOTLAND

1. House Of Elrick (ABV 42%) - £5.00

Bright, fresh and fragrant aromas, with juniper, florals and citrus. Juniper and rich citrus on the palate with floral rose and heather.

2. Porters (ABV 41.5%)- £5.00

Smooth, slightly rich mouthfeel with some hints of orange blossom honey. Quiet at first, it builds to a moderate intensity mid-palate, largely focused on fruit. Dried papaya and orange blossoms.

3. House Of Botanicals Old Tom Gin (ABV 475)-£5.50

Dry coriander, cinnamon, and ginger. Generally, quite spice forward, with a faint notes of caramelized sugar, citrus and waxy juniper.

4. Teasmith (ABV 43%) -£5.50

A careful blend of finely curated botanicals and hand-picked tea is what gives The Teasmith its characteristic taste. Juniper, coriander, grains of paradise, orange peel.

5. Gin Bothy Gunshot (ABV 37.5%) - £5.50

Gin is infused with cinnamon, cloves, and mixed spices.

6. Isle Of Harris (ABV 45%) - £6.00

Refreshing gin with a good balance between the bitter juniper and pine and the sweet fruit flavours of mango, grapefruit and orange. Made with sugar kelp.

7. Esker (ABV 40%) - £5.00

Clean and juniper led; this classic gin has its own distinctive notes with over a dozen botanicals, locally sourced silver birch sap, citrus and a hint of our floral botanicals.

8. The Botanist (46%) - £5.50

Woodruff, chamomile and herbs de provence. Warm juniper late with echoes of vanilla cream, liquorice and birch bark.

9. Gordon Castle (43%) - £5.50

Subtle notes of lavender linger in the back of the nose and within the mouth. Garden mint comes into focus helping promote the clean and refreshing character.

10. CAORUNN (ABV 41.8%) - £5.50

Fresh, superbly clean and balanced with piney juniper, zesty citrus, mild black pepper spice, light fruitiness and faint floral notes

11. GLASWEGIN (ABV 41.1%)- £5.50

Strong juniper and lime notes provide freshness with delicate orange flower notes for complexity. Locally sourced milk thistle and pink peppercorns round out the spirit for a finish so smooth that can be drunk with or without garnish.

12. Isle Of Bute Oyster Gin (ABV 43%) - £5.50

Uniquely flavoured, the oyster give a delicate maritime essence to this gin. Softly tangy with pineapple, though spicy touches of juniper and cardamom, as well as leafy coriander and mint

13. MAKAR CHERRY GIN (ABV 40%) - £5.00

Fragrant and piney on the nose, with juniper and rosemary. Full-bodied and smooth on the palate, with juniper and peppery spice. Dry and earthy on the finish, with juniper and rosemary.

14. Edinburgh Seaside - (ABV 43%)£5.50

This softly sweet, mineralistic gin uses botanicals that were foraged on beaches around Edinburgh, making the gin reminiscent of a bracing walk on a Scottish beach.

15. Smugglers (ABV 40%) - £5.50

Native Scottish botanicals such as Scots lovage, angelica root and coriander add crisp herbaceous infusions and distinct notes of pepper.

16. Great Glen (ABV 43%) - £5.50

Classic pine notes of juniper and citrussy coriander seeds are elevated by distilled Scottish raspberries, vapour infused rose & hibiscus petals and sweet Pink Lady apples.

ENGLAND

17. London No 3 (ABV 46%) - £5.00

Juniper to the fore, supported by floral notes and spicy, warm cardamom. Plenty of citrus 'zing' complemented by the gingery spiciness of coriander.

18. Tanguery No 10 (ABV 47.3%) - £5.75

Perfumed, aromatic nose with notes of tangy grapefruit zest, creamy custard and clean juniper.

19. TANQUERY (ABV 43.1%) - £5.50

Soft mouthfeel with juniper, bitter orange and lemon early. Mid-palate angelica and pink grapefruit shine through.

20. Tanguery Sevilla (ABV 41.3%) - £5.00

Crisp juniper and zesty orange flesh, supported by earthy vanilla and allspice.

21. Bombay Sapphire (ABV 40%) - £5.00

Tongue-coating flavours of juniper and pepper lead to a piney, prickly finish.

22. Three Seasons (ABV 45%) - £5.50

Fresh and slightly vegetal with a crunchy leafiness, hints of rocket and citrus. A powerful and oily flavour profile full of resinous juniper, fruity cedar notes and blossom with a little honeyed sweetness.

23. Tarquins (ABV 42%) - £5.50

Fresh piney juniper on the front of the leading to zesty lemon sherbet notes from the coriander, vibrant orange blossom from the fresh peels, rounded natural sweetness from the liquorice and an oily creaminess from the almonds.

24. Hyke (ABV 40%) - £5.50

Grape spirit, juniper, myrrh, nigella seed, rooibos, cumin, bay leaf, green cardamom, black cardamom, coriander, angelica root, angelica seed, orris root, liquorice root, aniseed, and lemon zest.

25. Conker (ABV 40%) - £5.50

New Forest gorse flowers, elderberries and samphire to contribute sweet, fresh and bitter elements to the gin.

26. Warners (ABV 40%) - £5.50

A gentle, spicy finish captures the essence of the coriander, cinnamon and angelica root.

27. Beaufort Smoked Overproof (ABV 57%) - £5.50

Bold smoky savoury notes, richly textured flavours of grainy cereals, cream soda, brown sugar and ginger spice.

28. Martin Millers (ABV 40%) - £5.50

Juniper, coriander, angelica, orris, cassia, cinnamon, liquorice, nutmeg, iris, and Seville orange.

29. Whitley Neill Rhubarb And Ginger (ABV 43%) - £5.50

The taste of an English country garden with a tart crisp edge of rhubarb and ginger

30. Whitley Neill Raspberry (ABV 43%) - £5.50

An initial and distinct juniper, coriander and liquorice flavour that gives way to a bright, fresh vibrant taste of Scottish raspberries.

31. Hendricks (ABV 43.4%) - £5.50

Fresh notes of cucumber with juniper, oak, a touch more citrus and vanilla. Creamy and savoury.

32. Hendricks Orbium (ABV 43.4%) - £5.50

This woody bitterness, which carries hints of mint and pepper, lingers on the back of the tongue, while flavours of citrus, cucumber, juniper and rose petals also emerge.

INTERNATIONAL

33. Boatyard Double Gin, Ireland (ABV 46%) - £5.50

Juniper, sweet gale, fresh lemon peel, coriander seeds, liquorice root, angelica root, orris root & grains of paradise.

34. Monkey 47, Germany (ABV 47%) - £5.50

Herbaceous juniper, blackthorne, lavender and an acute resiny pine note that comes across as more spruce/rosemary. As the taste progresses, we get peppery, vegetal notes, harmoniously entwined as if a single botanical. (Botanicals form the black forest)

35. Snowdonia, Wales (ABV 43%) - £5.50

The juniper becomes more earthy as sweet plums complement the citrus and balances with rising hints of oak spice

36. The Story Wines, Australia (ABV 42%) - £5.50

Finger limes, three different types of myrtle, wattle seeds, lemon-scented gum, all transport you to the smell of the Australian bush.

37. Roku, Japan (ABV 43%) - £5.50

You'll catch notes of cherry blossom, fruit, lemon, and notes of pepper, but it fades quickly and is overwhelmed by the base of the spirit.

38. Herno Old Tom, Scandinavia (ABV 43%) - £5.50

Fresh, crunchy green and spicy notes of coriander. A mellow sweetness combined with vanilla and cassia bark.
